

BABY BAZAAR STALLHOLDER INFORMATION PACK

Welcome to the Bathurst Baby Bargain Bazaar!
And thank you for your interest in running a stall.

The purpose of the Baby Bazaar is to provide parents with an opportunity to buy & sell pre-loved baby and kids items such as clothes, toys, books and equipment (high chairs, strollers, rockers etc).

As a stallholder you pay a small fee to rent a space at the Baby Bazaar where you can display and sell your items.

The Bazaar will also host a small area dedicated to stallholders with handmade or unique baby & toddler products as well as local services for babies & toddlers.

As the organiser we will promote the Bazaar to attract shoppers to buy your items. We will distribute flyers and posters locally to day-care centres, doctors surgeries, playgroups, mothers clubs, recreation facilities and so on. We will also promote the Bazaar through the local media to ensure shoppers turn up on the day to peruse the stalls.

How it works....

By ensuring that all items for sale are of high quality and undamaged we can guarantee our shoppers will find some bargains and save money when buying goods for their baby or toddler. This will also ensure that parents keep returning each season and future stallholders have plenty of shoppers to sell to.

For stallholders it is an opportunity to make back a little of the money spent over time on items that may not have been worn or used more than a handful of times before your child out-grew them. You can clear out storage space in one easy move without spending hours on the internet selling things one at a time.

If you have quality items to sell we are confident that you will make some money with relatively little effort.

Successful selling at a Baby Bazaar is about good display of your items. It is important to clearly group clothes into size and gender. Hanging more expensive items makes them easier to view. Laying out toys and books on a table makes them easy to see. It is also important not to over price your items. You can make more money by selling lots of pieces of clothing for a dollar each. You might package small things like bibs, muslins, socks etc into little bags where a few dollars buys a number of items.

BABY BAZAAR STALLHOLDER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. All clothes, bed linen and fabric items to be sold must be clean, freshly laundered and in good condition – i.e not torn, ripped or missing buttons.
2. All toys and equipment must be clean, safe for use and in good working order, in line with Australian Safety Standards.
3. Items that are damaged, broken or missing parts should not be brought to the Baby Bazaar for sale.
4. The sale of car seats and capsules is not permitted at the Baby Bazaar.
5. Cot mattresses should not be brought to the Baby Bazaar for sale. It is recommended that cots and cribs be sold without mattresses but that the seller can negotiate the sale of a good quality, bug free second hand mattress with the buyer, at their own discretion.
6. Whilst at the Baby Bazaar the stallholder is entirely responsible for the security of their items and their cash at all times, including whilst loading in, setting up and packing down. The organiser cannot guarantee against theft or damage of items being sold.
7. Whilst at the Baby Bazaar the stallholders are entirely responsible for their own safety and welfare. The organiser cannot guarantee against accident or injury.
8. The stallholder will follow the instructions of the organiser and staff at all times, as well as showing courtesy and respect to staff, other stallholders and shoppers.
9. The stallholder will observe the OHS guidelines and the setting up procedures (to be provided with access information closer to the date) whilst participating at the Baby Bazaar.
10. All fees must be paid at the time of booking a stall. Entry will not be permitted to stallholders who have not paid their fee. Fees cannot be paid on the day of the Bazaar.
